BIBLE VERSES:

ISAIAH 6:1-5

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory!" And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke. So I said: "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty."

REFLECTIONS ON WORSHIP:

1. Several of the songs focus on God's holiness. Why do you think the angels call out "Holy, holy, holy?" Why don't they cry out something else?
2. How might a proper understanding of God's holiness impact our worship? What can we learn from Isaiah's response to God?
3. What does it mean to worship God in spirit and in truth? Does true worship depend on going to a specific location or building on a specific day? How can we worship God daily?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Just for fun, what are the three main takeaways from this morning's message?
2. What does God's throne represent to us? What can we deduce from God's posture? What might be implied by God "sitting" in Isaiah's vision?
3. Do you find comfort in knowing God is exalted far above your circumstances? Does this mean that God doesn't care about what you are going through? What verses from this week and last apply here? Psalm 55:22 and 1 Peter 5:7
4. Why do we sometimes question God when we are going through something difficult? Does it make you feel better to blame God for your situation or thank Him despite it? What verse from this week applies here? 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18
5. I feel like I'm on the winning team. True or False? What difference does your answer make in how you approach life and in your daily interactions with others?

1. Pray for our community, those most at risk, and all those serving on the front lines, especially our local healthcare workers.
2. Pray for our leaders at every level.
